

# NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that a Public Hearing will be held Wednesday, August 3, 2022 at 1:30 p.m. in the Rich County Courthouse, 20 S. Main Street in Randolph. The Rich County Board of Commissioners is considering repealing and replacing the County's Beehive Ordinance (89-3). A copy of this proposed ordinance can be obtained by contacting the Rich County Clerk, Becky Peart at (435) 793-2415.

Rich County has had an ordinance since 1989 setting up a procedure for beekeepers to register their beehives with the County so that the beehives can be avoided when spraying for mosquitos. The County is considering repealing and replacing the ordinance. The proposed new beekeeper ordinance removes the registration fee and requires beekeepers to renew their registration annually and makes other technical changes.

The Board of Commissioners is soliciting the public's comments on the proposed ordinance. Those attending the hearing will be invited to provide their input. Those wishing to comment, but who are unable to attend the hearing may also submit written comments to the Rich County Clerk prior to the hearing.
