

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that a Public Hearing will be held Wednesday, August 3, 2022 at 1:45 p.m. in the Rich County Courthouse, 20 S. Main Street in Randolph. The Rich County Board of Commissioners is considering amending county ordinance 84-1 (An Ordinance Establishing Official Bonds and Setting the Amount Thereof). Utah State Code § 17-16-11 requires county officials to have some type of coverage in place to protect the County from misconduct. The statute allows counties to opt for either general fidelity bonds or theft or crime insurance coverage. In either option, the County Commission sets the amount of coverage required. The County is considering amending Ordinance 84-1 to opt for general theft or crime insurance to be provided by the County's insurance carrier: The Utah County Indemnity Pool (UCIP).

The Board of Commissioners is soliciting the public's comments on the proposed ordinance. Those attending the hearing will be invited to provide their input. Those wishing to comment, but who are unable to attend the hearing may also submit written comments to the Rich County Clerk prior to the hearing.
