


CERTIFICATION



**RICH COUNTY
2023 GENERAL ELECTION
TOWN OF LAKETOWN**

The Board of Canvassers of the Town of Laketown, Utah, met at the County Courthouse, 10 North 200 East, Laketown, Utah at 3 p.m. on Wednesday, December,6,2023 to conduct a canvass of returns from the 2023 Rich County General Municipal Election pursuant to Utah Code Unannotated 20A-4-304. The following members were present, constituting a quorum:

Anneliesa Peart conducted the canvass. A cursory review of the ballot tabulations was made. The results of the canvass are attached.

Mrs. Peart stated there were 303 ballots cast during the 2023 General Municipal Election. 309 ballots were processed, but six (6) were rejected due to the lack of voter signatures. The six (6) uncounted ballots were filed and will be sealed with the 2023 General Municipal Election results.

The number of ballots received by mail totaled 174, the number of military and overseas (UOCAVA) ballots totaled two (2), and the number of ballots received in person totaled 133. Zero (0) ballots were received by-mail after Tuesday, November 21, 2023. There were zero (0) voted provisional ballots. After counting the 174 by-mail ballots, the 133 in-person ballots, the two (2) UOCAVA ballots, zero (0) provisional ballots, and rejecting six (6) invalid ballots, the percentage of ballots counted was 100%, for a total of 303 ballots counted.

The number of ballots counted on election night was 298 for an election night voter turnout percentage of 66.52%. The number of ballots counted post-election night was five (5), constituting a total number of ballots cast at 303. The post-election voter turnout percentage was at 67.63%.

Mrs. Peart reviewed the audit procedures with the Board. Rich County was required to audit 100 ballots, which were randomly selected by the Lieutenant Governor's Office. The 100 ballots selected were verified using Electionware Software, and all the votes were visually verified and passed. Additionally, 3 voter signatures were audited separately – constituting a 1% audit – and successfully passed.

Election Official, Anneliesa Peart, followed all the noticing and reporting required by Utah State Code.

MOTION: A motion was made by Eldon Robinson to accept the results of the 2023 General Municipal Election as submitted by the Clerk-Election Official. The motion was seconded by Delora Wight and unanimously carried.
