

Town of Laketown: Voting By-Mail Ballot

- Your precinct is voting by-mail.
- Mark the ballot as per the instructions. Please use a black pen.
- If there is a place for a write-in candidate, only votes for valid candidates will be counted.
- **Complete and sign the affidavit on the back of the return envelope.**
- Refold the ballot along the fold lines.
- Insert and seal the ballot in the self-addressed, return envelope.
- Affix the proper postage and mail the ballot back, **POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN THE DAY BEFORE THE ELECTION.**
- Ballots may be dropped off at the following locations between Nov 1 – Nov 21:
 - Laketown Town Clerk's Office, 10 N. 200 E.
 - Mon/Wed from 9 am to 12 pm.
 - Rich County Clerk's Office (ADA Polling Place), 20 S. Main St., Randolph
 - Mon – Fri from 9 am to 5 pm (closed from 12 – 1 pm).
- In-person voting is available at the Rich County Clerk's office between Nov 15 – Nov 17, and on Nov 20 from 9 am to 5 pm. Then on Election Day, Nov 21, between 7 am and 8 pm.

Town of Randolph: Voting By-Mail Ballot

- Your precinct is voting by-mail.
- Mark the ballot as per the instructions. Please use a black pen.
- If there is a place for a write-in candidate, only votes for valid candidates will be counted.
- **Complete and sign the affidavit on the back of the return envelope.**

- Affix the proper postage and mail the ballot back, **POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN THE DAY BEFORE THE ELECTION.**
- Ballots may be dropped off at the following locations between Nov 1 – Nov 21:
 - Randolph Town Clerk's Office, 20 S. Main St.
 - Mon – Wed from 9 am to 4 pm (closed from 12 – 1 pm).
 - Rich County Clerk's Office (ADA Polling Place), 20 S. Main St.
 - Mon – Fri from 9 am to 5 pm (closed from 12 – 1 pm).
- In-person voting is available at the Rich County Clerk's office between Nov 15 – Nov 17, and on Nov 20 from 9 am to 5 pm. Then on Election Day, Nov 21, between 7 am and 8 pm.
