

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that a Public Hearing will be held Monday, April 3, 2023 at 1 p.m. in the Rich County Courthouse, 20 S. Main Street in Randolph. The Rich County Board of Commissioners is considering amending the Rich County ordinance entitled: An Ordinance Requiring Businesses to Purchase a Business License (no. 82-4). A copy of this proposed ordinance can be obtained by contacting the Rich County Clerk, Anneliesa Peart at (435) 793-2415.

The Utah Code states “the legislative body of a county may by ordinance provide for the licensing of businesses within the unincorporated areas of the county for the purpose of regulation, and may impose fees on businesses to recover the county’s costs of regulation;” Utah Code § 17-53-216. Rich County has had an ordinance in place requiring business licenses in unincorporated Rich County since 1982. The County is considering amending this ordinance to comply with subsequent changes in Utah’s state code. The amendment would also lower the annual license fee from \$100 to \$50 per year.

The Board of Commissioners is soliciting the public’s comments on the proposed ordinance. Those attending the hearing will be invited to provide their input. Those wishing to comment, but who are unable to attend the hearing may also submit written comments to the Rich County Clerk prior to the hearing.
