

# NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that a Public Hearing will be held Monday, April 3, 2023 at 1:15 p.m. in the Rich County Courthouse, 20 S. Main Street in Randolph. The Rich County Board of Commissioners is considering amending or repealing an ordinance entitled: An Ordinance of Rich County, State of Utah, Enacting an Adjoining Landowners Ordinance, Pertaining to the Construction and Maintenances of Fences in Rich County for Agricultural Purposes, for Provisions for Payment by Adjoining Landowners and for Provisions for Nonpayment, including Costs and Attorney's Fees (97-09-03). This ordinance sets out the duties and rights of neighbors sharing a fence for agricultural purposes. Rich County has had this ordinance in place since 1997. In the intervening years, these same topics are largely now regulated under Utah state code. See Utah Code § 4-26-101 to 103. The Commission is now considering amending the County's ordinance to be entirely consistent with state code or repealing it altogether.

The Board of Commissioners is soliciting the public's comments on the proposed ordinance. Those attending the hearing will be invited to provide their input. Those wishing to comment, but who are unable to attend the hearing may also submit written comments to the Rich County Clerk prior to the hearing.
